Bonillas	Any solid color polo or turtleneck. Tan, beige, khaki or navy slacks, shorts, skorts, skirts or jumpers in cotton, twill, or corduroy. Any solid color sweater or sweatshirt.	1983 – 1984	Approved April 22, 1983 - Amended June 21, 2005
Dodge Middle	<u>Dress Code not uniforms</u> – white, light blue or dark (forest) green shirts with collars and sleeves; black or khaki pants. Dresses or Jumpers must be solid colored in black or tan or match the dress code top garment color choices (listed above) in cotton or cotton twill blends. Dresses must have a sleeve or be worn over a dress code top. No pullover hoodies allowed. Jackets with college/university logos are allowed providing the jacket is still able to completely open down the front.	Unofficially in place 96 – 97 (1986 dress code)	April 14, 2017
Doolen Middle	Shirts with sleeves & collar in white, gray or burgundy (maroon); shorts, capri pants in navy or khaki--no cargo or denim. Any jacket. Sweatshirt with crew or zip. Tennis, athletic or leather closed toe shoe. Tops & bottoms no more than 1 size larger.	2007-2008	March 13, 2007
Grijalva Elementary	White, navy blue and dark burgundy polo shirts and navy or khaki bottoms.	'98	March 10, 1998
Johnson Primary Elementary	Navy blue clothing for the bottom garment, all white or all maroon clothing for the top garment.	'98	February 10, 1998
Lawrence Intermediate	Navy blue pants, skirts and shorts, and white or maroon polo-style shirts.	'98	February 10, 1998
Lynn/Urquides Elementary	All white shirts/blouses, Lynn/Urquides t-shirts tucked in, blue bottoms.	00 – 01	March 7, 2000
Mansfeld Middle	Navy blue bottom garments and white collared top garments.	August 15, 1995 (approved by Governing Board as a pilot program.)	March 19, 1996
Manzo Elementary	Blue bottom garment and white top garment.	96 – 97	May 27, 1996
Maxwell Middle	White, navy and khaki. Any two of the three colors may be worn with collared shirts.	99 – 00	April 6, 1999

Roberts-Naylor K-8	White, gray, green and navy blue or any shade of blue polo shirts or collared shirts or collared shirts with long or short sleeves and buttons. No blue on blue (blue pants with same shade of blue shirts). Collared shirts must be visible at all times. Boys: Navy blue or Khaki pants, shorts for boys(uniform style) Girls: Navy blue or Khaki pants, shorts, skorts, jumpers, capris (uniform style). Only loose fitting pants	15-16	July 14, 2015
Robison Elementary	White or navy blue polo shirts with three buttons or collared shirts with sleeves and buttons for boys and girls. Navy blue or khaki pants and shorts for boys—Dockers or uniform type (no basketball or gym shorts/pants). Navy blue or khaki pants, shorts, skorts, jumpers, capris for girls—Dockers or uniform type (no basketball shorts or warm-up suits). Closed toed shoes (with socks) such as tennis shoes or flat-heeled leather shoes must be worn by boys and girls. Wright Elementary	White or navy blue polo shirts with three buttons or collared shirts with sleeves and buttons for boys and girls. Navy blue or khaki pants and shorts for boys—Dockers or uniform type to be worn with a belt (no basketball or gym shorts/pants). Navy blue or khaki pants, shorts, skorts, jumpers, capris for girls—Dockers or uniform type (no basketball shorts or warm-up suits). Closed toed shoes (with socks) such as tennis shoes or flat-heeled leather shoes must be worn by boys and girls.
